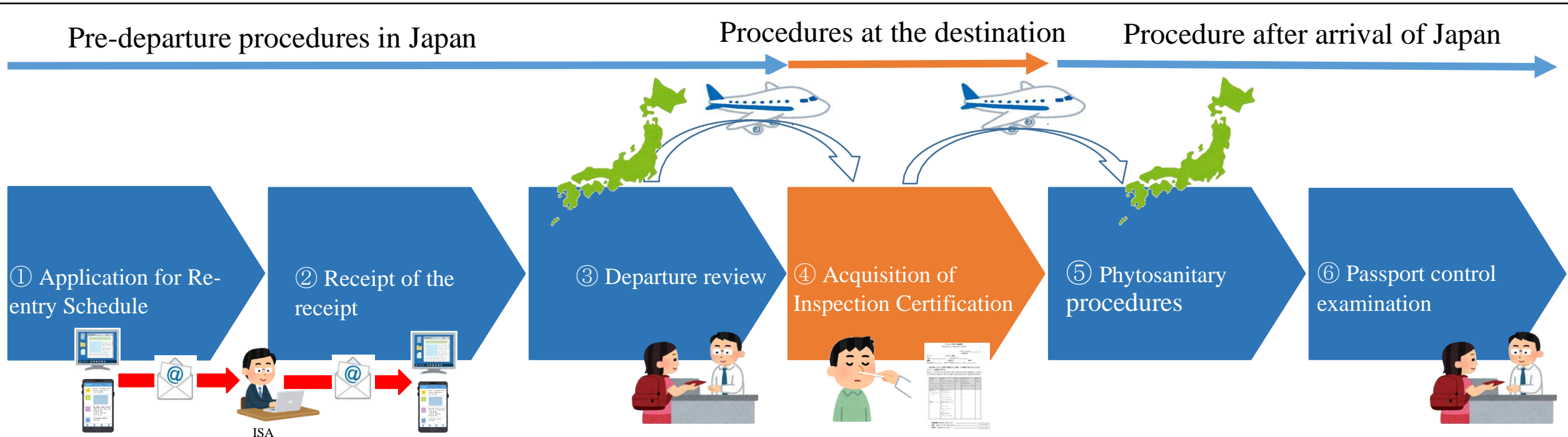


# Flow of Re-entry Procedures for Holders of Status of Residence During Their Stay in Japan



<p>Send departure information to the Immigration Services Agency (ISA). Subject of email needs to be:</p> <p>再入国予定の申出について</p> <p>Details on what information the emails need to include, and the email address can be found here</p> <p><a href="http://www.moj.go.jp/contnt/001327551.pdf">http://www.moj.go.jp/contnt/001327551.pdf</a></p> <p>Note that email address depends on where you live.</p>	<p>The ISA will send back a via email a confirmation that they have received and approved you request.</p> <p>※ Please note that this receipt is required if you are planning to come back.</p>	<p>Present the receipt (see previous steps) to the immigration examiner at the departure check.</p> <p>※ A receipt may be presented either as a print or by showing the received e-mail on your smartphone.</p>	<p>Obtain an inspection certificate (hereafter referred to as "inspection certificate") that proves "negative" by examining COVID-19 within 72 hours prior to departing from the country or region where you are staying.</p> <p><a href="#">Examination certification format</a></p>	<p>Please be tested for COVID-19 at a testing booth (quarantine station) at the arrival airport.</p>	<p>During the passport control, after the COVID-19 test, submit the re-entry receipt and the certificate of inspection (the overseas COVID-19 test result) to the immigration inspector.</p> <p>※ If you do not have an examination certificate, you may be denied entry.</p>
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
