



How to Enter Japan after October 11, 2022

1. Required Documents

- ✓ **negative result from a COVID-19 test** taken within 72 hours prior to departure, done at a medical facility,
or
- ✓ **certification** that the person has been vaccinated with WHO-approved vaccines at least three times

Note:

- Japan recognizes [only certain testing and sample collection methods](#)
- There are certain [requirements regarding the vaccination certificate](#).
- Children below the age of 18 who travel together with triple-vaccinated parents/guardians are also exempt from the test

2. Fast-Track Entry (Pre-register required documents and data)

- ✓ **Entry before November 14** : it is highly recommended to use the MySOS app for uploading all required information (personal data, passport, and COVID-19 test result or vaccination certificate) before your journey to allow for a fast-track entry into the country. The required information should be filled in at least a few hours before departure. With children aged 12 or younger: you can register each one individually.
- ✓ **Entry on and after November 14** - the MySOS app will be replaced by the improved "**Visit Japan Web**", scheduled to go online on November 1. It will allow travelers to enter not only COVID-19 related documents, but also immigration and customs related data.

3. Masks in Japan

Expert recommendations about mask wearing

- ✓ Required:
 - Indoors and outdoors when having conversations in close distance
 - Indoors when not being able to maintain social distancing, e.g. on public transportation.



When asked

✓ Not required:

Outdoors when you can keep social distance or pass others without much talking.

Indoors when you can keep social distance and little conversation is being made.
