- 59 responded post webinar questionnaire
- 72% of respondents rated the webinar useful ~ quite useful





- 3) Overview & Remarks
- Positive & negative aspects of DiGA were presented, based on the actual cases after law enforcement in 2020
  - + : many cases (153 up to end Oct. 2022) applied due to the benefits of the process
    - speedy introduction of SaMD with temporary reimbursement defined by manufacturers
    - clinical usefulness verified with RWD during temporary approval period
  - : many cases (84 cases) withdrawn due to insufficient preparation significant reduction of reimbursement after final approval
- Feedback of participants
  2 step approval process would be applicable to Japanese system
  temporary reimbursement point by manufacturers might not fit to Japan
